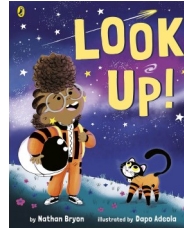
Space

English

In English the children will be reading the books Toys in Space and Look Up!. They will retell the stories in these books in a variety of ways creating story maps and using small world figures and puppets.

When looking at the book Look Up! They will be learning technical aspects of persuasive writing and creating their own piece of persuasive writing. They will also be looking at personal narratives.

The children will create lost posters and write poetry when look at the book Toys in Space. They will also be learning to predict.



Computing

We will be using Purple Mash for our computing and the children will be learning how to logon to purple mash safely, use an avatar and navigate the purple mash website.



Art and D.T.

In art children will be creating a variety of space inspired images including coffee filter planets, an alien creation and the moon. They will be also be using mixed media to create a space inspired image. We will also be making simple prints.

R.H.S.E

We will be talking about Personal Relationships and 'special people' in their lives who they love and can trust. In further sessions, children will learn how to cope with various social situations and dilemmas, and the importance of saying sorry and forgiveness within relationships.

We will then move on to life online and how to stay safe online.

Music with Mrs Woodcock

Year 1 are learning about Samba and music from Brazil. They will learning about traditional Samba instruments and use them to play Samba rhythms. Children will be listening to carnival music and learning how to sing the song Bambo du Bambu.

Maths

In maths this term, the children are starting with their place value within 20 and understanding 10s and 1s.

They will look at using a number line up to 20 and estimating up to 20, as well as comparing and ordering numbers up to 20.

We will then move on to addition and subtraction within 20.

Science:

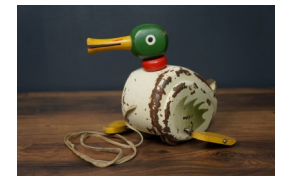
Scientists and Inventors
