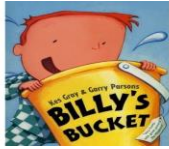


English

Maths

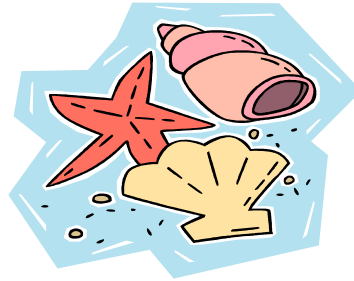
In maths we will be learning about geometry: being able to describe position, direction and movement including whole, half quarter and three quarter turns. We will then revisit our work on place value, extending our range of numbers up to 100. Our money topic is always fun and practical. We will set up a seaside shop and work on being able to recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes. Finally, we will learn about time; being able to sequence events in chronological order, tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and begin to measure time.

Computing

We are storytellers. We will be creating a talking book that we can share with our family and friends. We use the i-pads to enhance our learning.

History – Seaside Holidays

We will be comparing seaside holidays in the recent past with those taken a long time ago. Children will sequence events and learn to ask and answer questions about different sources of information. We will be visiting the seaside and learning some of the history of our city.

RSHE - Changes

We will be talking about dealing with uncomfortable feelings e.g. jealousy and loss. We will listen to stories, have discussions and make suggestions of ways of dealing with these feelings. We will also be thinking about the changes that have happened in our lives so far and thinking about how things will change in the future.
